## Southeastern Regional Relocation Council (SRRC) 2020 Scholarship Application

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### Background

The Southeastern Regional Relocation Council (SRRC) is a non-profit industry association providing corporate and service industry relocation professionals the opportunity to meet and work together on a regular basis to educate, learn and share knowledge and experiences about current relocation practices and emerging relocation issues to better serve and address the needs of relocating employees and their families. As part of our commitment to relocation, the SRRC has developed a scholarship program for current high school seniors who have been relocated to South Florida sometime between grades 9 (after 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation) and 12. **The one-time award will be presented to an area high school senior this year (Residence eligibility is defined as a senior attending a public, private, or charter school in South Florida - Broward, Collier, Dade, Hendry, Monroe, Palm Beach Counties).** The award will be sent to the college that the student will be attending in the Fall of 2020 to assist with tuition, etc.

The SRRC will select the scholarship winner based on the strength of their total application. The student will be evaluated on academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and on their written essay addressing the challenges associated with relocating to a new area and a new high school.

### Requirements

#### **Applicants must meet these requirements:**

- Currently a senior in good standing in a Florida high school.
- Has relocated more than 50 miles and changed schools due to their family's relocation between grades 9 and 12
- Currently have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 (or equivalent if different scale)
- Must provide SAT/ACT scores (documented)

#### **Please submit the following information, along with your completed application, signed by your Guidance Department:**

- 1) List (on a separate sheet) all your extra-curricular activities & work experience during high school.
- 2) Please write an essay addressing the following:  
Tell us about your experiences associated with your relocation to Florida. Please feel free to discuss your family background, challenges encountered with the relocation, and successes achieved. We would also appreciate any advice you would give to another teenager preparing to relocate (as you did)! The essay should be between 1,000 to 1,500 words and must be **e-mailed in a Word document format.**

**Deadline for applications must be received by February 7, 2020 please: no exceptions to this deadline.** The winner will be asked to present their story/essay in a video for our membership to view.
